Family Scavenger Hunt

Note to parents:

Today is all about having fun and making sure each member of the family knows that they are unique and loved by God.

There are 3 parts to the scavenger hunt.

1. Scavenger Hunt
2. Creative activity with the items found
3. Bible reflection - using some of the items

1. Scavenger Hunt

- Each person in the family gets their own print -out and collect the items or split into teams
- The pictures have been added to allow non-readers participation in the groups!

2. Creative Activities (gather around your table or on the living room floor)

Using the items in your bag try and create some of the following:

- ⇒ House
- ⇒ Flag
- ⇒ Car
- ⇒ Face
- ⇒ New kind of animal
- ⇒ Have the kids suggest fun things to build

Bible reflection:(use the A4 paper / pen and photo)

- Write words on your paper that would describe something beautiful and special.
(*You could each give a word in the group and everyone then writes that down on their paper example: fantastic, awesome, great, terrific, mind-blowing, jaw dropping....*)
- Then read Ps 139: 13-1
- Tell the kids : God looks at you and would use all these words to describe you— you are so special and amazing—created by God!
- Tell them to put their picture in the middle of the page. Never forget that God planned you and loves you.

Pray for each one to know and grow in the knowledge of God's love. Ask God to help them be the version of themselves God wants them to be.
